Hire Charges

Effective from: 26th November 2012

The Rules of Hire for Winterton Hall are available from Plaistow Stores with the Booking Form. It is a legal requirement that those hiring the Hall agree to abide by the Rules of Hire.

Capacity Limits

For functions with seating at tables 80 people
For dancing, or for closely seated audience 140 (without stage); 120 (with stage)

PRIVATE HIRE

Per hour: £ 9.00
10-24 hrs: £90.00

Note: All private hirers are required to leave a separate deposit cheque of £50 when booking the Hall. Deposit cheques will be destroyed (or returned, if requested) within one week of the hire period ending, unless further cleaning is required.

USE OF STAGE (ALL PARTIES)*

Per period of hire: £12.00

If the stage is required, this must be arranged in advance when booking the Hall. The stage may only be erected and dismantled by a member of the Committee to ensure safety.

Note: power & heating; hot water

- Lighting and background heating is included in the hire charge; the controls on the night storage heaters should not be adjusted.
- The hirer pays for all other power - from sockets, for hot water boiler and kitchen appliances, showers; and for supplementary heating (from two electric wall heaters and / from the two electric bar heaters at ceiling height).
- Electricity is paid by meter, which takes 50p coins only. The coin meter is in the meter cupboard, and is marked *HALL POWER*.
- If used, both showers and electric bar heaters need to be turned on from the meter cupboard, where marked, and switched off when leaving.
